LEGAL NOTICE**

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the Shelby County Commissioners located at 129 East Court Street, Sidney, Ohio 45365, until 11:00 A.M. local time on APRIL 15, 2010 at which time and place bids will be opened publicly and read aloud for the **SHELBY COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT BACK-UP GENERATOR PROJECT**. Proposals received after 11:00 A.M. local time will be returned unopened.

The project consists of the supply and installation of a 60 kW/75 kVA Kohler diesel generator operating at 120/208 volts and includes rewiring existing electrical service and panels, 400A service rated automatic transfer switch, remote monitoring, concrete foundation, and acquiring building and electric permits.

Plans and specifications can be picked up at the office of the Shelby County Commissioners, Annex Building, 129 East Court Street, Sidney, Ohio 45365. The non-refundable cost of the packet is \$10.00.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at the Sidney-Shelby County Health Department, 202 W. Poplar St., Sidney, Ohio on April 6, 2010 at 10:00 A.M.

Each bid must include the required submissions per the bid specification packet and must be accompanied by either a bid bond in an amount of 10% of the bid amount or by a certified check, cashiers check, or letter of credit upon a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the bid amount. A 100% Performance Bond will be required after the contract is awarded to cover the installation period. Bid security in Bond Form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

Each bid must be sealed and contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Bids shall be clearly marked as **Bid for Shelby County Health Department Back-Up Generator** and mailed or delivered to:

Each bidder must submit, upon request, evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity. The owner intends and requires that this project be completed no later than July 15, 2010.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio Products, materials services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Shelby County, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Department of Industrial Relations.
