

# RULES OF ADULT PROBATION

All probationers are required to follow the rules of probation set by the Shelby County Common Pleas Court. The rules are as follows:

1. You shall not violate any federal, state or local laws and shall obey all rules, regulations and orders of the Shelby County Common Plea Court.
2. Offender shall not associate or communicate with any person who has a felony record, a substantial criminal record or is known to be involved in criminal activity.
3. You shall contact your Probation Officer no later than 24 hours after you have been arrested or have had contact with a law enforcement officer. You shall not enter into any agreement or other arrangement with any law enforcement officer or agent which might place you in the position of violating any law or condition of your supervision.
4. Offender shall be employed regularly. When out of work, or changing jobs, offender shall notify his/her Probation Officer immediately. You must secure advance approval before changing jobs, taking on an additional job or quitting a job.
5. You shall follow the instructions and advice of your Probation Officers in all matters during the entire period of your probation and shall answer all questions honestly and completely.
6. You shall abstain from the use of any drug of abuse. You shall not frequent any place where alcoholic beverages are sold or dispensed in any matter, such as card rooms, pool halls, bars and sports bars. If you are attending drug or alcohol counseling, you are to abstain from any alcohol consumption or mind altering substance.
7. You shall not own, possess, or have under your control any firearm, dangerous ordinance, or weapons of any type.
8. You shall not possess, use, sell, distribute, or have under his/her control any illegal or illicit narcotic drugs as defined in the Ohio Revised Code, or any instruments for administering them except on prescription of a licensed physician or pharmacist.

9. The Probation Officer has the right to visit him/her at home or elsewhere. The Offender will be subject to a search of person or property by a Probation Officer.
10. Offender shall submit to random periodic urinalysis testing as required by a Probation Officer to determine the presence of illegal drugs or alcohol at a cost of \$10 to be paid at time of testing.
11. Offender shall make regular payments as directed by the Shelby County Adult Probation Department on restitution, fines, court costs and drug tests. If the Offender is, or becomes employed, he/she will be required to have payments withheld from their regular pay in an amount determined by a Probation Officer.
12. Offender shall report to his/her Probation Officer as determined by the Probation Officer or the Adult Probation Department.
13. You shall not enter upon the grounds of any state or federal correction facility nor attempt to visit any prisoner without the written permission of your Probation Officer, nor shall you communicate with any prisoner without first informing your Probation Officer of the reason for such communication.
14. You shall establish a permanent residence and shall report it to your Probation Officer. You shall not change your residence, telephone number, or address without permission of your Probation Officer during the entire period of supervision. You must reside in Shelby County for the duration of your probation. You also must maintain a private line telephone.
15. You shall observe a daily curfew of 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.
