The Shelby County Board of Commissioners intends to apply to the Ohio Department of Development, Office of Housing and Community Partnerships for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Water & Sanitary Sewer Program, a federally funded program administered by the State of Ohio. If the application is approved, up to \$600,000 will be granted to the Shelby County Commissioners to help pay for constructing the new sewer facilities project in the Village of Kettlersville.

On February 16, 2010, the Shelby County Commissioners held their First Public Meeting to explain the requirements of the CDBG program. A second public meeting has been scheduled for **Thursday, April 8th, at 7:30 p.m. at the Van Buren Township Hall, 8833 North Street in the Village of Kettlersville** to discuss the proposed CDBG Water and Sanitary grant application under consideration. Citizens are encouraged to attend this meeting and provide input.
